Your choice of test: Intro Level, Training Level & CT Tests through Intermediate will be ridden in a small arena. Advanced CT & First Level Test 2 & higher & FEI in standard arena.

3. Draw checks to: VHT/PDF. Refunds before closing date in full. After closing date No cash refund but can be applied to another “Fest” show.

4. Post entries available when scratches occur. Negative Coggins required within 12 months

5. Tentative Schedule: 8:00 am CT dressage. 10:00 a.m. S.J. & 1:00 p.m. X.C. Dressage Show entries approx. noon

6. Awards: 6 ribbons in all classes.

8. Stabling: Limited – Call Molly Bull for availability (434) 286-4592

9. Directions: Take 64 to exit 121. Go south off the ramp, towards Scottsville, on Route 20. Go about 12 miles to the small town of Keene. Turn left on Cole's Rolling Rd (Rt 712) immediately after the Greene Mtn Country Store. The farm is 1 mile down on left, but please use EARLIER ENTRANCE into field BEFORE YOU GET TO MAIN ENTRANCE.

10. Dress: casual, but neat and tidy. Must wear proper boots, breeches, ASTM approved hardhat and Body protecting Vest & Medical Armbands (available at show) for all jumping phases

11. Level requirements: HT & CT dressage with jumping heights & speed.

Cross – Country will have an added test : “Technical Merit Test ” Earn Bonus points on your XC score with TM points, based on a 1 – 10 scale.

Green: - walk/trot, Intro Test **B**: Jumps 18" - 2'. 6-8 show jumping cross-rails, obstacles in an enclosed area.
CT only no XC

AG (Advanced Green) – **2006 Beginner Novice Test B**: Jumps 2' – 2'6 show jumping verticals and small gates 8- 10 obstacles **CT only no XC**

BN – **2006 Beginner Novice Test B**: Jumps Max. 2'8". XC – approx 12 fences @ 300 mpm

NR/NH– **2006 Novice Test A**: Jumps Max 2'11". XC – approx 15 fences @ 350 mpm

ON –**2006 Novice Test B** : Jumps Max 2'11". XC –approx. 15 fences @ 350 mpm

TR/TH – **2006 Training Test A**: Jumps Max 3'3". XC- approx 18 fences @ 400 mpm

OT – **2006 Training Test A**: Jumps Max 3'3". XC- approx 18 fences @ 400 mpm.

P – **2006 Preliminary Test A**: Jumps max 3'7". XC – approx 18 fences @ 450 mpm

OP – **2006 Preliminary Test B**: Jumps max. 3'7". XC - approx 18 fences @ 450 mpm

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY
Plain Dealing Farm , July 11, 2009 .

I am aware that horseback riding, hunting, riding to hounds and other equine activities are athletic events which pose potentially serious risks of injuries or death to their participants. I understand that my horse(s) or I may be injured or die as a result of my negligence, the negligence of others, or through no fault of myself or anyone else, because of the nature of the activity in which I am going to be engaged. I also understand that horses, even the most well trained, are often unpredictable and are often difficult to control.

With this waiver I accept notice of the provisions of the Equine Activity Liability Act, §§ 3.2-6200 through 3.2-6203 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, which state in part: "(i) the propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways which may result in injury to the participant; (ii) the inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons or animals; and (iii) the hazards of surface or subsurface conditions. The waiver shall remain valid unless expressly revoked by the participant or parent or guardian of a minor, in writing, with receipt acknowledged by Penny Ross & Brian Ross, Virginia Horse Trials LLC, Fairfield, Virginia.

Furthermore, with this waiver, I expressly assume the risk of injury or death due to negligence by the Penny Ross & Brian Ross, their agents, employees, members, officers, directors, and staff, for my own safety or for the safety of my minor child.

With the knowledge of the foregoing, and as an inducement for **Linda Wachtmeister & Plain Dealing Farm** to allow me to ride on their property, I hereby agree to waive or release any and all rights that I or my heirs may have to make a claim against for **Linda Wachtmeister & Plain Dealing Farm**, their employees and participants, arising from any damages, injury, or death which I might sustain or which might occur to any horse's) I am riding as a result of my horseback riding. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless all of the foregoing from any claims which I might make or which might be made on my behalf by others or which might be made against me by others, arising from riding on their property. Furthermore, I agree to indemnify for **Linda Wachtmeister & Plain Dealing Farm**, their employees, or any landowners, their families, employees or tenants, for any injury, death, loss or damage to any personal property which might occur during an equine activity as defined by § 3.2-6203 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, or social functions sponsored by Penny Ross & Brian Ross, Virginia Horse Trials LLC or held in their behalf or for their benefit, when such injury, death, loss or damage occurs on their property.

BY SIGNING THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE, I UNDERSTAND THAT I AM GIVING UP, (WAIVING AND RELEASING) ANY RIGHT I MIGHT HAVE TO SUE OR MAKE A CLAIM WHICH I MIGHT HAVE OR WHICH MIGHT SUBSEQUENTLY ARISE OR OCCUR AGAINST PENNY ROSS & BRIAN ROSS, VIRGINIA HORSE TRIALS LLC AND PARTICIPANTS, OR ANY LANDOWNERS, THEIR FAMILIES, EMPLOYEES OR TENANTS, OVER WHOSE LAND I RIDE, FOR ANY INJURIES I MIGHT SUSTAIN WHILE HORSEBACK RIDING OR PARTICIPATING IN AN EQUINE ACTIVITY, AND THAT I AM INDEMNIFYING AND HOLDING HARMLESS, PENNY ROSS & BRIAN ROSS, VIRGINIA HORSE TRIALS LLC AND EMPLOYEES, AND/OR ANY LANDOWNERS, THEIR FAMILIES, EMPLOYEES AND TENANTS, OVER WHOSE LAND I RIDE, FOR INJURING ANYONE ELSE OR ANY HORSE RIDDEN BY ANOTHER WHILE SO ENGAGED. IT IS MY INTENT TO GIVE UP THOSE RIGHTS AND PROVIDE THE HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT, AND I DO SO KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY.
